

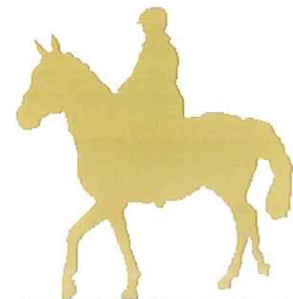
Lindenwood University President Dr. James D. Evans has announced the American Quarter Horse Association Scholarship Program. Four awards are available ranging from \$2,500-\$9,000 annually to top high school graduates who have demonstrated significant academic and youth leadership within the American Quarter Horse Association.

### Additional Criteria

Candidate must apply and remain continuously enrolled as a full-time undergraduate resident student in good academic and social standing. Candidate must be a new student not previously contacted by Lindenwood University, and does not have to be a freshman. Academic scholarship programs are restricted to freshman status. Candidate must receive no other institutional aid except as approved by the Dean of Admissions. Candidate must complete a financial aid application to determine eligibility for state or federal aid. Candidate must understand that any additional outside grants or scholarships will first replace Lindenwood University funding. All grants/scholarships awarded by Lindenwood are subject to students meeting the admission requirements set forth by the university and are not transferrable to other Lindenwood University campuses. Lindenwood University grants/scholarships are intended for individual use and are not intended for any group, institution, or organization. Lindenwood University grants/scholarships may not be combined or stacked. Participation in extracurricular activities and/or student life sports will not be in addition to the Outstanding Student grant/scholarship programs. NCAA athletic scholarships will be in addition to the Outstanding Student Grant/Scholarship programs.
